**Park completion adds to Fisher's list**

Now that Marina Park is open, Brevard County Commission Chairman Robin Fisher says he can check something off his "bucket list" of things to do.

Fisher, who represents North Brevard, was clearly ex-

cited during Monday's ribbon-cutting ceremony for the park, attended by about 200 people, including County Manager Howard Tipton and several other county and Titusville officials. The \$3.2 million downtown Titusville park features a skateboarding park and an off-leash dog park.

Titusville Mayor Jim Tulley told attendees that the ribbon-cutting marks "a great day for Titusville, and it's a great day for the citizens." He compared the process of designing the park to that of skateboarders practicing their stunts, saying, "we planned and we fell down and we got up," until coming up with the final plan for the park along the Indian River.

Marina Park is owned by the city of Titusville, and operated and maintained by Brevard County Parks and Recreation Department's North Area Parks Operations.
