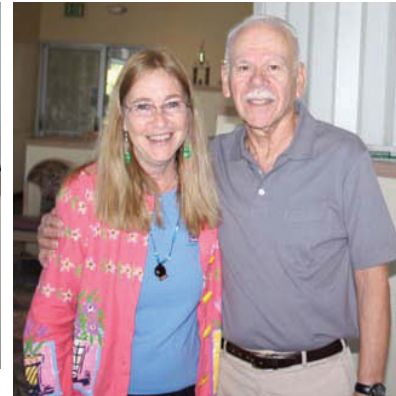


## Keep Brevard Beautiful Recognizes Volunteers

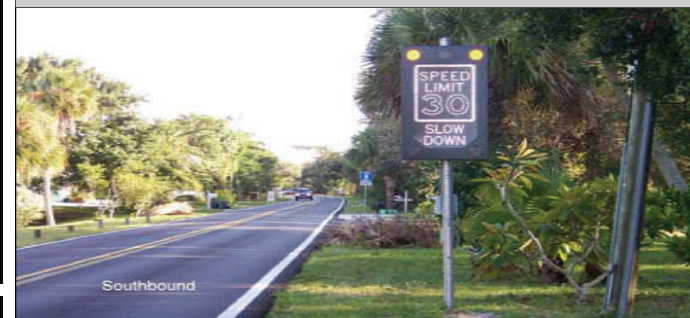

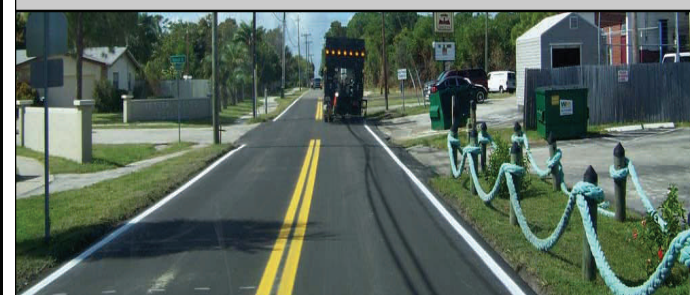
