Pitch, Hit & Run Competition Scheduled for Youth

ROCKLEDGE, Fla. – Brevard County’s Central Area Parks & Recreation will host free Aquafina Major League Baseball Pitch, Hit & Run competitions at McLarty Park in Rockledge on Sunday, March 21. Registration begins at 11 a.m. and the competition is from noon to 2 p.m.

Boys and girls, ages 7 through 14, will compete in separate divisions for a chance to advance through four levels of competition, including team championships at major league ballparks and the national finals in Anaheim, California.

Youth may compete at only one location, and all participants must provide a copy of their birth certificate and fill out a registration/waiver form. No metal cleats are allowed.

Pitch, Hit & Run is the official skills competition of Major League Baseball. The program is designed to provide youngsters with an opportunity to compete in a competition that recognizes individual excellence in core baseball skills.
