**Brevard Emergency Manager Appointed to  
FEMA National Advisory Council**

ROCKLEDGE, Fla. – Brevard County Emergency Management Director Bob Lay has been appointed to the Federal Emergency Management Agency’s National Advisory Council by administrator Craig Fugate.

The National Advisory Council incorporates state and local government and private sector input in the development and revision of the national preparedness goal, the national preparedness system, the National Incident Management System, the National Response Plan and other related plans and strategies. The council provides recommendations to FEMA to ensure effective and ongoing coordination of preparedness, protection, response, recovery and mitigation for natural disasters, acts of terrorism, and other man-made disasters. The membership of the NAC represents influential, high-level senior leaders of their organizations, stakeholder groups, and the private sector or members of the public.

Lay, who has 18 years of emergency management experience, will serve a one-year term as one of just three Emergency Management officials on the prestigious 35-member national council.
