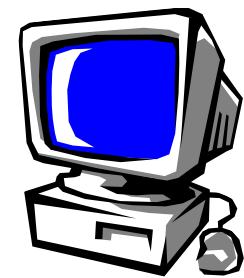


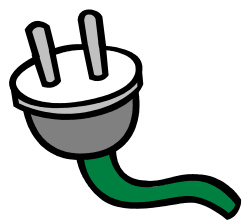

Electronic equipment is everywhere in the modern home and office. Both per capita ownership and discards of TVs, computers and other electronics are increasing and will probably continue to do so in the foreseeable future. **Cathode ray tubes (CRT)** found in almost every television and computer monitor are the most problematic material in the end-of-life electronics waste stream due to their lead content. CRTs are the second largest source of lead in Florida's municipal solid waste stream just behind lead acid batteries.

Brevard County's household electronic recycling program will allow homeowners and commercial generators to **get the lead out** of the waste stream by properly disposing of or recycling their electronics. Since ninety percent of the electronic equipment can be either used or recycled, we encourage homeowners and commercial generators to do their part in making our environment a safer one.

The disposal of commercially generated CRT's in the County's landfills is prohibited.
